Policy Topic	Development Status	Comments
Additional Compensation	A policy development plan (PDP) is being written	This new policy will address “in-load” versus “overload” compensation for faculty and staff.
Alcohol Use – Students & Student Organizations	A draft policy is in development	This policy revision will address use of alcohol by student organizations at off campus venues.
Conflict of Commitment	A policy team is be formed and a PDP will be written	This policy revision will replace the existing Conflict of Interest policy.
Copyright Ownership	Conceptual stage	Policies need to be revised to adequately address ownership of copyrights, artwork, software, courseware, syllabi, etc.
Effort Reporting	A policy development plan (PDP) is being written	This new policy will formalize existing unwritten policy regarding effort reporting.
Event Authorization & Notification – Recognized Organizations	A draft policy is in development	This formalized policy and related procedures will assist students and recognized student organizations in planning and executing successful events throughout campus.
Graduate Assistant Benefits	A draft policy is in development	This new policy will provide for a consistent minimum of paid leave for graduate assistants.
P&S Compensation	A draft policy is in development	The new policy will replace four existing policies related to P&S salary increases, salary structure, starting rate of pay, and change in status.
Records Retention	Policy finalization is awaiting updating of the records retention schedule	The revised Records Retention policy, guidance, and schedule will indicate responsibility, provide guidance, and specify required time periods for records retention.
Research/Academic Misconduct	A draft policy is in development	This policy revision will apply to externally funded activities, and will combine the policies currently located in the Faculty Handbook and P&S Handbook.
