5 As allowed by Iowa Code Section 262.9 (18), Regent universities may utilize non-tuition components of the
6 general university funds first. Accordingly, general university funds remaining at the close of a fiscal year are
7 comprised solely of student fees and charges.

8 **Policy Statement**

9 As authorized on June 13, 2007 by Board of Regents Policy Manual Section 7.03 A (5), Iowa State University
10 will utilize non-tuition components of the general university funds first.
