4 Introduction

5 This policy complies with Chapter 99B and Chapter 725 of the Iowa Code.

6 Policy Statement

- 7 In accordance with Chapter 99B and Chapter 725 of the Iowa Code, organized groups recognized through the university
- 8 may conduct licensed bingo, raffles, carnivals, games of skill, and games of chance.
- 9 The campus is under a single gambling license that covers any of the named activities except one where the proceeds are
- 10 not being retained on campus. An example would be a campus chapter of a national organization holding a raffle where the
- 11 proceeds would be sent to the national headquarters. In that case, the organization would need to obtain a separate
- gambling license. This, and other information regarding the program, can be obtained at the Campus Organizations
- 13 Accounting Office.
- 14 The total gross proceeds of the event are subject to the current sales tax rate for Ames, Iowa. The Campus Organizations
- 15 Accounting Office will compute the tax and deduct it from the account where the proceeds were deposited.
- 16 Procedural regulations and decisions governing bingo, raffles, etc. including the number of such events to be held at any one
- 17 time will be determined by the University's Event Authorization Committee. The Iowa State University Center, Memorial
- 18 Union, Department of Residence, Campus Organizations Accounting Office and Facilities Planning and Management may
- 19 further regulate such activities.
