- 7 Classified projects entail restrictions on the dissemination of the results and/or products of the
- 8 project.

9 Policy Statement

- 10 University policy does not allow the acceptance of classified research projects except in very rare
- cases. Any exception to this policy must be approved by the vice president for research, by the
- 12 senior vice president and provost, and by the president of the university.

13

- 14 The Office of Sponsored Programs Administration will review all contracts and agreements prior to
- acceptance to assure that the results of research under sponsored projects are not constrained by
- unacceptable restrictions related to the publication of research results.

- 18 The university recognizes that in some instances, such as those involving development of
- commercially applicable or patentable products or techniques, disclosure of results from certain
- 20 research projects may need to be withheld for a limited period of time.

21

- 22 Theses and dissertations should not incorporate research that cannot be made public at the time the
- 23 final examination is held; therefore, graduate students should not be engaged on sponsored projects
- that may restrict their rights for publication. Any exceptions to this regulation must have prior
- approval of the dean of the Graduate College.
