- From time to time circumstances may arise that make students unable to continue their enrollment as an ISU
- 5 student for the remainder of the current term. If the timing of this occurs after the first day of the term or any
- point prior to finals week, students must initiate the withdrawal process in order to formally discontinue their
- 9 university enrollment. This is a collaborative process that requires student responsibility, student affairs and
- 10 academic affairs partnership, and central coordination.

Policy Statement

- 12 Undergraduate, graduate and professional students seeking to withdraw from Iowa State University as defined
- by this policy must comply with the processes established by the Office of the Registrar. Withdrawal from the
- university is categorized in four classifications, each with distinct processes and documentation
- requirements. These classifications include:
- Standard Withdrawal,
- Medical Withdrawal,
- Out of Term Withdrawal, and
- University Initiated Withdrawal.
- 20 Further, additional guidelines for returning to the university may apply for students who repeatedly request
- withdrawal to ensure appropriate support services are in place to facilitate student success. The applicable
- 22 procedures and processes for each withdrawal classification are maintained by the Office of the Registrar. See
- 23 Resources below.
- 24 Cancellation of course registration prior to the first day of the term ("Course Cancellation" or "Withdrawal from
- 25 Admission") is not within the purview of this policy.
