- 6 Iowa State University encourages the use of language and illustrations that create an environment of
- 7 respect for human diversity, individual rights, and the equal dignity and worth of all human beings. It
- 8 also discourages the use of language and illustrations that reinforce demeaning attitudes,
- 9 assumptions, and stereotypes or overlook certain populations.

10 Policy Statement

- 11 All university publications and communication, whether oral or written, shall use inclusive language
- 12 and illustrations. Inclusive language refers to language that makes every attempt to include
- comprehensively all groups in the community. Whenever possible, selection of academic materials
- will also reflect efforts to uphold this university policy.
- 15 Compliance with this policy shall be the responsibility of all faculty and staff. The offices of diversity
- and inclusion, equal opportunity, multicultural student affairs, dean of students, senior vice president
- and provost, and the president, and the Margaret Sloss women's center shall address concerns and
- supply guidance as requested and appropriate.
