- 6 This policy provides reporting requirements for accidents and injuries sustained by students
- 7 while in academic classes or events sponsored by Iowa State University.

8 Policy Statement

9 Reporting

- All accidents and injuries sustained by Iowa State University students while in academic classes
- or events sponsored by the university must be reported to the Office of Risk Management (ORM)
- by the student and a university representative.
- 13 Incidents involving hospitalization or death:
- Within 8 hours, report the incident to both ORM, 515-294-7711, and the Department of Public Safety (DPS) 515-294-4428.
- Complete the online ISU Incident Form (see Resources below).
- o An ISU Net-ID is required to use the online ISU Incident Form. If you do not have an ISU Net-ID, contact ORM at 515-294-7711 or claims@iastate.edu.
- 19 Incidents not involving hospitalization or death:
- Complete the online ISU Incident Form (see Resources below).
- o An ISU Net-ID is required to use the online ISU Incident Form. If you do not have an ISU Net-ID, contact ORM at 515-294-7711 or claims@iastate.edu.
- 23 This documentation will assist the university in taking appropriate steps or corrective measures
- 24 to eliminate hazards that may be connected with university activities.
- 25 Incidents occurring after regular business hours must be reported to the Department of Public
- Safety. Additional assistance is also available from the Dean of Students Office.

27 Emergency Medical Assistance

- 28 Dial 911 to reach emergency assistance to send an ambulance in life threatening situations
- 29 (respiratory difficulty, chest pain, profuse bleeding and unresponsiveness).

30 Non-urgent Medical Services

- 31 The Thielen Student Health Center is available on campus to provide non-urgent medical
- 32 services for students, but does not have emergency room services. Calls to the Thielen Student
- Health Center during regular business hours are answered by a registered nurse. After regular
- business hours, First Nurse, an advice line staffed 24 hours a day by a registered nurse,
- answers calls to the Thielen Student Health Center telephone number.
