5 Introduction

6 This policy complies with Chapter 99B and Chapter 725 of the Iowa Code.

7 Policy Statement

8 In accordance with Chapter 99B and Chapter 725 of the Iowa Code, organized groups recognized

9 through the university may conduct licensed bingo, raffles, carnivals, games of skill, and games of

- 10 chance.
- 11 The campus is under a single gambling license that covers any of the named activities except one
- 12 where the proceeds are not being retained on campus. An example would be a campus chapter of a
- 13 national organization holding a raffle where the proceeds would be sent to the national
- 14 headquarters. In that case, the organization would need to obtain a separate gambling license. This,
- and other information regarding the program, can be obtained at the Campus Organizations
- 16 Accounting Office.
- 17 The total gross proceeds of the event are subject to the current sales tax rate for Ames, Iowa. The
- 18 Campus Organizations Accounting Office will compute the tax and deduct it from the account where
- 19 the proceeds were deposited.
- 20 Procedural regulations and decisions governing bingo, raffles, etc. including the number of such
- 21 events to be held at any one time will be determined by the <u>Campus Organizations Accounting</u>
- 22 <u>Office</u>. Activities may be further regulated by--
- 23 The Event Authorization Committee
- The <u>Memorial Union</u>
- 25 Facilities Planning and Management
- 26 The lowa State Center
- The Department of Residence
