6 As allowed by Iowa Code Section 262.9 (18), Regent universities may utilize non-tuition components
7 of the general university funds first. Accordingly, general university funds remaining at the close of a
8 fiscal year are comprised solely of student fees and charges.

10 As authorized on June 13, 2007 by Board of Regents Policy Manual Section 2.2.3.A (i)(c), Iowa
11 State University will utilize non-tuition components of the general university funds first.
