4 Introduction

- 5 This policy complies with the legal requirements for making timely payments to vendors as stated in
- 6 Code of Iowa, Chapter 8A.514(3).

Policy Statement

- 8 By state law, suppliers to the university are allowed to charge one percent per month interest on
- 9 invoices for goods and services satisfactorily provided and not paid within 60 days. Interest becomes
- 10 payable sixty days following the receipt of the claim (invoice), or the satisfactory delivery or
- furnishing of the services, supplies, or materials, whichever date is later.
- 12 Federal funds are not subject to this law. Claims paid with both federal and nonfederal funds will
- have only that portion charged to nonfederal funds assessed interest charges.
- 14 With the potential cost of interest charges, it is important that invoices be promptly processed and
- any disputes brought to the attention of the appropriate purchasing agent, where they will be
- 16 resolved in a timely manner.
