5 Introduction

- 6 A "utility locate" is a service performed by a utility authority to identify the location of underground
- 7 utilities. State law requires utility locates to be completed prior to any work that disturbs the surface
- 8 of the ground.

9 Policy Statement

- 10 Utilities must have an advance notice of at least 48 hours (not including weekends and holidays) to
- allow sufficient time for completion of the locates. Requests for locates should be directed to
- 12 Facilities Planning and Management (FP&M). The utility enterprise will provide locates of all
- underground utilities on an as-requested basis to coordinate any excavation, installation of signs.
- stakes, and tents, and other work that requires the surface of the ground to be disturbed at a depth
- greater than two inches.
