The Committee will:

- Provide guidance and final determinations on the classification of data consistent with the **Data Classification Policy** and **Data Classification Standards and Guidance**
- Approve data security and sharing plans
- Regularly review the **Minimum Security Standards and Guidance** to insure they are still necessary and effective.
- Approve exceptions to the Minimum Security Standards

- Human Resource Services
- Vice President for Research and Economic Development
- Office of the Registrar
- Office of the CIO
- University Policy Administrator
- Internal Audit, non-voting
